Financial Assistance for Cancer Patients who have been affected by Hurricanes Katrina and Rita.

Grants from \$1,000 - \$2,500 per family are provided to assist with the costs of:

- Medical equipment such as wheelchairs and prostheses
- Cancer treatments such as chemotherapy and hormonal therapy
- Medical co-pays for patients
- Medicine for nausea, pain, and other side effects
- Homecare and childcare
- Transportation and lodging
- General Living Expenses

Financial assistance is offered to clients who meet CancerCare eligibility criteria.

In addition to financial assistance, CancerCare provides free professional support services to cancer patients and their loved ones. CancerCare social workers can provide callers with telephone counseling both for individuals and in groups, educational information and programs, and practical help, all free of charge.
